If frayed wires or exposed conductors are found, or any other faults, the equipment is not to be run until replaced or repaired by a competent person and rechecked.	Operator	Low

Repetitive Strain Injuries	Participants	Constant repetitive movements can lead to injuries. Game is unlikely to cause Repetitive Strain Injuries during normal use. If pain or discomfort is experienced then the participant is to stop playing.	Operator	Low	
Bruising due to repetitive hitting of the buttons	Participants	Bruising may be experienced if the buttons are repetitively hit with excessive force. Operator to ensure that participants do not use excessive force.	Operator	Low	
Collapse of the control unit due to wind loading	Participants & Bystanders	If the game is operated outdoors then the control unit will be subjected to windloading. If this is likely then they must be restrained with securely anchored guy ropes. In very high winds or if the game is unused for a period of time then it shall be dismantled.	Operator	Low
